indeed I have not any.

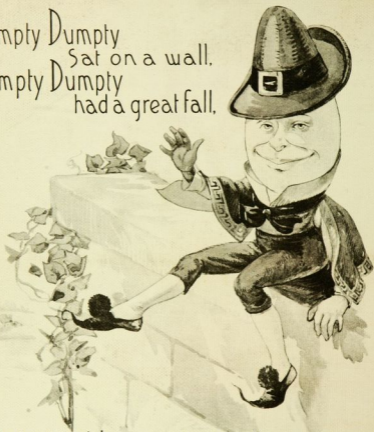


Little Jack Horner sat in a corner
Eating a Christmas Pie.



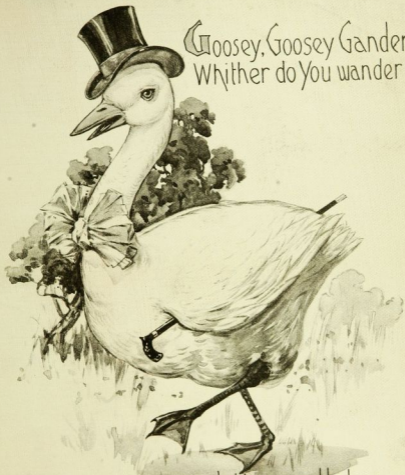
He stuck in his thumb and pulled out a plum
